KANE OBLIQUE

Kane Oblique has been making beats in the same Peckham bedroom since 2019 — two tapes deep, no label, and a reputation built entirely on word of mouth.

The sound is boom bap with the dust left on: knocking MPC drums, off-kilter samples, and verses that trade punchlines for weight. Live, it's just Kane, a drummer, and the MPC — no laptop, no backing track — a show that has quietly turned first-time listeners into regulars across South London. LONG WAY DOWN, the new tape, is the fullest picture yet: five tracks about the routes home you take when the last bus has gone.



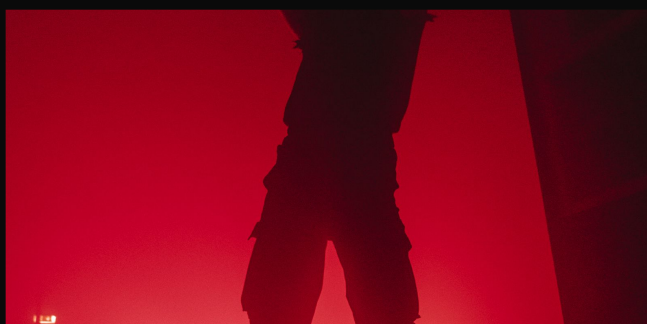
Peckham's best-kept secret makes tape you play twice — once for the bars, once for the beats.

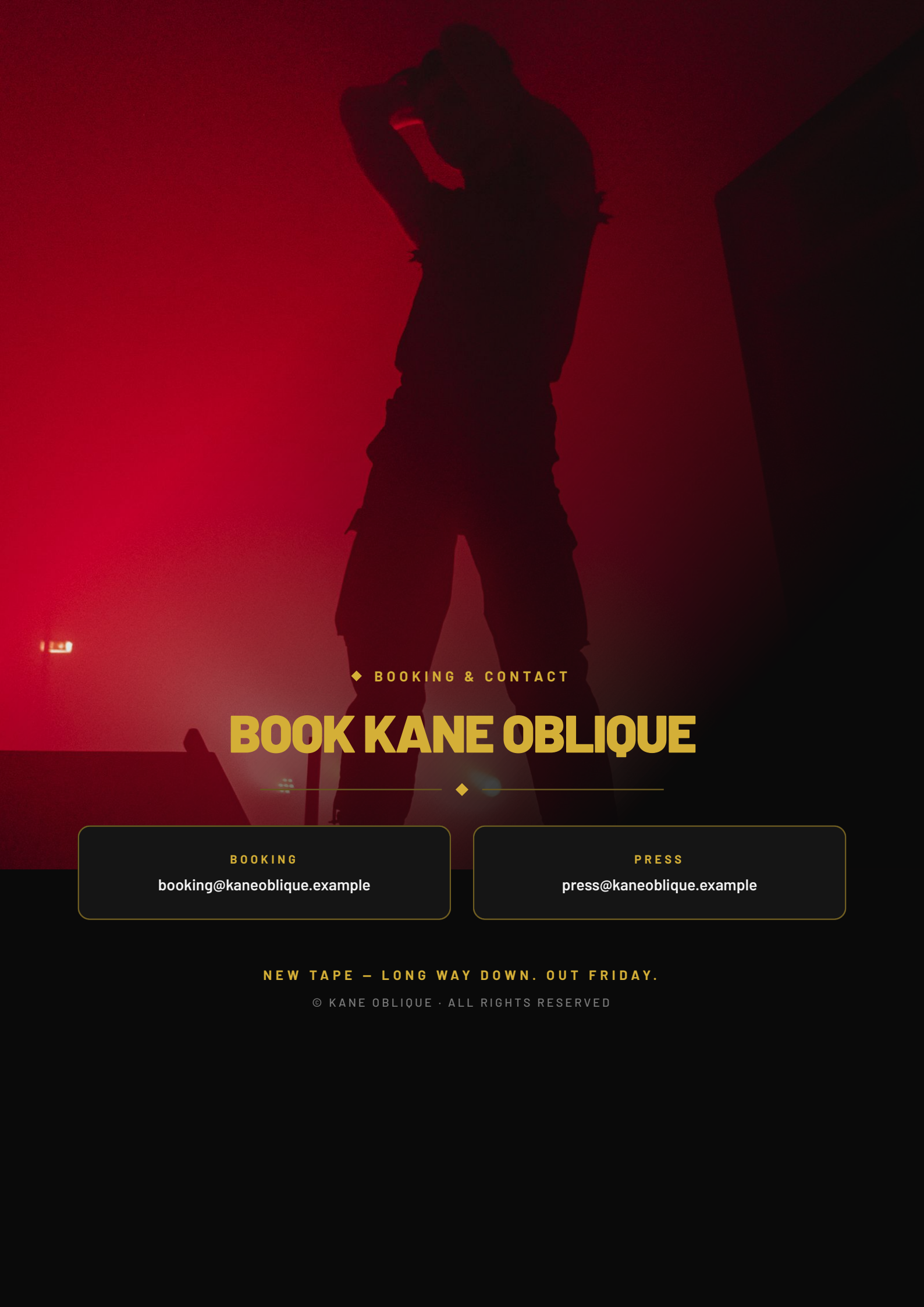
